RESERVE FUND POLICY

Adopted: January 16, 2024

PURPOSE

The reserve fund serves as a measure of the financial resources available to a government agency. The Reserve Fund Policy establishes a range at which the General Reserve Fund balance should be maintained. This policy is established to provide financial stability, cash flow for operations, and the assurance that the Library will be able to respond to emergencies with fiscal strength.

RESERVE FUNDS

The Following Reserve Funds are being established:

Employee Benefit Accrued Liability Reserve Fund

To pay employees upon leaving for earned but unused PTO: \$1,000

403B Retirement Employer Match Reserve Fund

To cover board-directed contributions to employee retirement accounts; percentage to be determined by board annually: \$2,000

Professional Fees Reserve Fund

To cover legal fees, financial reviews and/or audits, and other professional fees: \$7,000

Technology Reserve Fund

To cover the cost of computers printers, laptops, iPads, and related equipment as needed: \$2,000

Professional Development Reserve Fund

To cover employee educational costs as they relate to their library positions: \$2,000

NYS Mandated Employee Sick Time Leave Reserve Fund

To cover anticipated sick leave usage. Each part-time employee can take a maximum of 60 hours of sick leave per year: \$2,500

Library Repair Reserve Fund

To include parking lot sealing, outside painting, possible roof repair, gutter cleaning, fence repair, possible toilet replacements, and/or other repairs: \$5,000

Patron Programing Special Reserve Fund

For special events not included with annual budget: \$3,000

MONITORING

Reserve fund balances may fall occasionally outside of the target ranges because of special projects, construction, emergencies, other extenuating circumstances, and/or levy restrictions.

This Reserve Fund Policy will be reviewed on an annual basis by the Bloomfield Public Library Board of Trustees.
