About the 2025-2026 Budget

2025-2026 Budget Increase

The Bloomfield Public Library is asking residents of the Bloomfield Central School District to vote for the library's 2025-2026 funding. The library is asking voters to support a \$326,577 tax levy which represents an overall budget increase of \$6,359 from last year.

Drivers of increased operating costs include mandatory wage increases, as well as increase in utility costs, insurance increases, and increased costs for building and property maintenance. Additionally, the library strives to fairly compensate it's qualified and dedicated staff with competitive wages and benefits.

Approval of the proposed budget will enable the library to continue serving the Bloomfield community in a fiscally responsible manner, while reflecting the library mission to educate and enrich by providing essential resources and opportunities. The library is committed to increasing accessibility to the array of services that are offered to the Bloomfield community. With the passage of this budget, the library will continue the forward movement towards the growth and utilization of the library.
